

	• The responses collected are required to be analyzed and an essay/report has to be submitted based on the data so collected.
	Subsequently, a viva will be conducted on the same for the Assessment of Speaking Skills.
	Guidelines:
	• Students have to work in groups of four to five. The groups will be decided by the teachers for their respective classes.
	 Proper allocation and distribution of tasks to be done amongst the group members and a page on acknowledgment should be enclosed in the project file.
	 A detailed questionnaire has to be circulated by each group to at least 20 people (as mentioned above). The responses collected have to be analysed. An Essay/ Report (200-250 words) has to be submitted based on the data so collected.
	• Evidence in the form of a Google Survey Form / Pictures / a Speaking task based on the findings in the form of a Panel Discussion & PPT shall be presented for Assessment of Speaking skills. The transcript for the same first needs to be submitted and discussed with the respective teachers.
